To ensure a positive and safe experience for all participants, Kids College welcomes children with a wide range of physical, verbal, social, and cognitive differences. We strive to make reasonable accommodations to support their participation. However, please understand that our Kids College instructors are not specifically trained or staffed to provide dedicated one-on-one attention or critical personal care. Therefore, for campers who require this level of support, we respectfully request that a Parent, Guardian, or Professional Caregiver accompany the child during their time on campus. Kids College classes meet Monday-Thursday (4 days). Each class runs 45 minutes.

Following registration for KidsCollege, a detailed confirmation will be emailed to your home. *Please be advised that you will be required to be with your child at sign-in and sign-out each day and show a photo ID to sign-out your child.* Parents or Guardians are welcome to encouraged to visit any class their child is attending.

Also, we are looking for **volunteer classroom assistants** for all Kids College courses. There will be one classroom assistant spot for each class. Drop off and pick up
